Effective Teacher Commands: Establishing Classroom Control

the instructor believes that students should know why they are being told to do something, the teacher should deliver a brief explanation prior to the command • give the student a reasonable amount of time to comply Once the teacher has given a command, he or she should give the student a reasonable timespan (eg, 5 -15 seconds) to comply
