According to the colophon on fol. 67a (illus 2), the copy was completed on 4 Rab'i I 668 (= 1 November 1269) by the physician Abu al-Fadi Ibn Abi al-Hasan from an autograph copy in the hand of the author, Ibn al-Nafis.
