Following Wodak et al. (1999), national identity "is constructed and conveyed in discourse, predominantly in narratives of national culture. National identity is thus the product of discourse" (p. 22). Conceived in language, rather than blood (Anderson, 1983, p. 133), nations and national identities, when perceived as imagined communities, are essentially socially constructed.
